

USING THE INTERNET

To locate a specific website while using a URL¹ (web address²):

- 1) Begin by finding the word "location" then look immediately to the right of the word at the WHITE BOX which should contain the URL for the web page that you are currently viewing.
- 2) In this long box being typing a URL (web address) and to make Netscape go to the location you want to see press your ENTER key on your keyboard, or click on the button that says, "**go**".
- 3) Your selected website should begin loading now.
- 4) Look at the lower left-hand corner of your browser screen to follow progress as your website loads. It will show words like "contacting³ host⁴", "host contacted⁵", "transferring data⁶", or "document done⁷".
- 5) If the words read "document done" your page is finished loading. You may now use your scroll bars to move down the page and view its content.

The text style of "***bold italic***" text is used to indicate something that you must do to accomplish what is described.

The text style of "**bold type**" is used to indicate a specific wording to look for.

The text style of "underline" is used to indicate an object to look for.

³ Contacting host means that your computer is busy "calling" the other computer.

⁴ A host is another computer that contains the information that you are trying to see.

⁵ Host contacted means that the other computer that you are trying to "call" has responded.

⁶ "Transferring data" means that the information that you have requested to see is currently being moved from the other computer into your computer so that you can see it.

⁷ "Document done" means that the information has all been moved into your computer and is ready for you to see it.
